

## The Look of Genesis

Sebastião Salgado, one of the world's most respected photographers, is set to debut his latest work—the Genesis series—in Hong Kong with a solo exhibition at the Sundaram Tagore Gallery. Having visited more than 100 countries, Salgado has made it his life's work to document the impact of globalisation on humanity. Through his works, he sets out to capture the fragility and fortitude of the human spirit. The exhibition unveils new works from his Genesis series, including startling depictions of landscapes, wildlife, and human communities. Commenting on this ongoing project, the Brazilian-born, Paris-based photographer says: "It was designed to reconnect us to how the world was before humanity altered it almost beyond recognition." The exhibition will also display several iconic works from earlier in Salgado's career, including an image of surging crowds at Mumbai's Church Gate Station.
