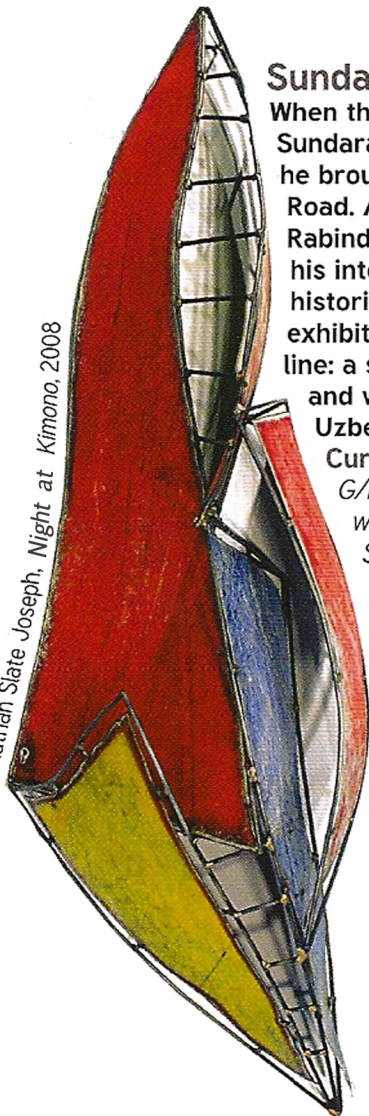


Nathan Slate Joseph, *Night at Kimono*, 2008



### Sundaram Tagore Gallery

When the New York-based art historian and gallerist Sundaram Tagore decided to open a space in Hong Kong, he brought a wave of fresh inspiration to Hollywood Road. A descendant of poet and Nobel Prize winner Rabindranath Tagore, the gallerist immediately inserted his intellectual edge into the district, with a series of historically important, and sometimes museum-quality, exhibitions. Their exhibition in June continues along this line: a series of three-dimensional paintings, sculptures and wall-mounted vessels by the New York-based, Uzbeki-Israeli artist Nathan Slate Joseph.
